New renewables come from facilities that first began commercial operation on or after January 1, 1998. Eligible hydroelectric are defined as facilities whose output is equal or less than 30 megawatts.

For comparison, the average mix of resources supplying New York includes: Coal 5%, Natural Gas 35%, Large Hydroelectric 23%, Nuclear 32%, Oil <1%, and <5% Other.
